# **L** Customer Service and Contact

How Can I Speak to a JetBlue Airlines Representative Fast? / How do I get a human at JetBlue airlines immediately?

The fastest way to reach a live representative is by calling the main customer service line at **1-866-JETBLUE** (**1-866-284-3014**). This line is staffed **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**. To save time, use the **Live Chat** feature on JetBlue.com or the mobile app, which is often faster for common issues.

## How to get ahold of JetBlue airlines?

You can contact JetBlue through:

- **Phone:** 1-866-284-3014 (24/7).
- Live Chat: Via their website and mobile app (24/7).
- **Dedicated Lines:** Mosaic members and JetBlue credit card holders have access to priority phone support.

# ☐ Carry-On and Checked Baggage

What can I carry on JetBlue airlines? / What can you take on JetBlue airlines? / How many bags can you carry on JetBlue airlines?

Most JetBlue fares (Blue, Blue Extra, Blue Plus, Mint) include one free carry-on bag and one free personal item.<sup>1</sup>

Bag Type	Maximum Dimensions (Including Wheels/Handles)	Storage Location
Carry-on Bag	\$22 \times 14 \times 9\$ inches	Overhead Bin
Personal Item	\$17 \times 13 \times 8\$ inches	Under the seat in front of you

**Crucial Blue Basic Rule:** If you purchase the cheapest **Blue Basic** fare, you are **only allowed one personal item** unless you are a Mosaic member, flying a transatlantic route, or have an eligible JetBlue credit card.<sup>2</sup> Any standard carry-on bag brought to the gate with a Blue Basic fare will incur a fee.<sup>3</sup>

# Tickets, Changes, and Refunds

Can you change name on airline ticket JetBlue? / Can I change the name on my JetBlue airline ticket?

No, +18 ➤ 662 ➤ 843 ➤ 014 ➤ you generally cannot change the ticket to a different person (Name Change). This would require canceling the original ticket (subject to fare rules) and booking a new one at the current fare. However, Name Corrections (minor spelling fixes, or legal changes due to marriage/divorce) are usually permitted but require you to contact JetBlue directly, as they cannot be done online.

# How to change name on JetBlue airlines ticket?

For minor spelling corrections or legal name changes, you must **call JetBlue Customer Service**. They will handle the correction, which often involves booking a new reservation and applying the original fare rules, ensuring the final name matches your ID.

# Can I change a nonrefundable airline ticket JetBlue?

Yes, for most fares (Blue, Blue Plus, Blue Extra, and Mint), JetBlue has eliminated change fees.<sup>4</sup>

- Change: You can change your flight date or time, but you must pay any difference in the airfare between the original ticket and the new flight.
- Cancellation: If you cancel a nonrefundable ticket, you will receive a **JetBlue Travel Credit** for the value of the fare difference, which is valid for one year from the original ticketing date.
- Blue Basic Exception: Blue Basic fares generally have a non-waivable change/cancellation fee (ranging from \$100 to \$200) plus any applicable fare difference.<sup>5</sup>

#### Are JetBlue airline tickets refundable?

# It depends on the fare type:

- **Refundable Fares:** These are specifically designated as Refundable (e.g., Blue Refundable) and are eligible for a full refund to the original form of payment if canceled before the flight's scheduled departure.<sup>6</sup>
- Non-Refundable Fares: (Most common fares) Result in a travel credit if canceled.
- **24-Hour Rule:** Regardless of fare, all reservations made **seven days or more prior to departure** are eligible for a **full refund if canceled within 24 hours of booking.**<sup>7</sup>

#### Can JetBlue rebook me on another airline?

JetBlue's primary policy is to rebook passengers on the next available JetBlue flight.<sup>8</sup> Because JetBlue is not a member of a major global alliance (like Star Alliance or oneworld), they rarely have contractual agreements to rebook passengers on other airlines (known as interline agreements) unless a widespread travel disruption forces them to do so. If your flight is canceled, your primary options are a refund or rebooking on a subsequent JetBlue flight.<sup>9</sup>

# **5** TrueBlue Miles and Booking

Can JetBlue miles be used on other airlines?

Yes, TrueBlue points can be redeemed to book flights on JetBlue's partner airlines directly through JetBlue.com. 10

- **Key Partners:** This includes **United Airlines** (under the "Blue Sky" partnership), **Qatar Airways, Etihad Airways, and Icelandair.** <sup>11</sup>
- **Redemption:** You must search and book the partner flight using points on the JetBlue website.

## Where does JetBlue airlines fly?

JetBlue serves over **100 destinations** across the **United States, Latin America, the Caribbean, Canada, and Europe**. Key focus cities are New York (JFK), Boston (BOS), and Fort Lauderdale (FLL).

### How to book a JetBlue airlines flight for holiday?

- 1. **Book Early:** Holiday travel prices peak early; book flights **6 to 9 months in advance** for the best fares.
- 2. **Use TrueBlue Points:** Search for flights using TrueBlue points, as the redemption cost is tied to the cash price, meaning you can often still get good value even during peak season.
- 3. **Check Neighboring Airports:** Compare prices at nearby airports, such as checking JFK, LGA, and EWR if traveling to the New York area.
- 4. **Book Direct:** Book via **JetBlue.com** or the app to easily manage changes and ensure proper application of TrueBlue points.<sup>12</sup>
